Hellevad

Where the good life starts

The village of Hellevad was born around a ford - a place that builds bridges, and it still does. There is a sense of community across all age groups, interests and backgrounds.

In the centre of the town is Gustes Eng, a recreational area with a fire pit and open-air stage, where residents meet in everyday life and at several large annual events, not least of which is Hellevad Open Air, the annual music festival.

"Hellevad Børneunivers" houses an integrated toddler group and kindergarten, school to year 7 and an after school club. The school works closely with the town and the sports association, which has resulted in new playgrounds, a zip line, parkour track and a large multi-purpose field.

The nature around Hellevad offers open spaces, streams and forests. The Hellevad Rundt project has marked several hiking and running routes in the neighbourhood.

Bov, Kruså, Padborg, Smedeby and Frøslev are located like beads on a string along the Danish-German border, by the city of Flensburg and Southern Denmark's vital transport centre. The local business community is dominated by the transport industry with a staggering 3,000 employers. It is a historically important area, with numerous associations and organisations. Several times a year, the locals get together for the annual border race, tilting at the ring tournaments and open air concerts.
